Access to delegate contact details is subject to UK data protection laws and GDPR compliance. UKATA cannot guarantee that delegate information will be available unless explicit consent is given by attendees.

3. Unavoidable Occurrences

Should the conference be cancelled, postponed, or rescheduled due to unforeseen circumstances beyond the organisers' control (including but not limited to government regulations, natural disasters, or public health concerns), UKATA shall not be liable for any refund, loss, or damage incurred by sponsors or exhibitors.

4. Corporate Recognition

Inclusion of sponsor logos and corporate branding in event materials is subject to publication deadlines. UKATA will make every effort to maximise exposure but cannot guarantee placement in all marketing materials.

5. Advertising & Promotions

7. Cancellation Policy

- 50% cancellation fee if cancelled between 60-90 days before the event.
- No refunds for cancellations made within 60 days of the event.
